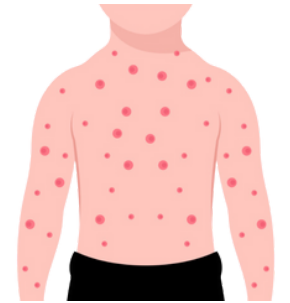

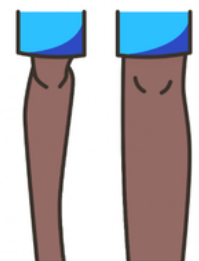
Programs with no community protection against the spread of **POLIO**
